- Joe Mangialardi from King Pharmaceuticals described new medication techniques to help prevent drug tampering.
- Cheryl DeHaven presents her Foster Care Recruitment Plan. She is seeking homes in Willcox for foster care especially for the ages 9 – 17. Thirty hours of training is required which consists of 3 hours/10 weeks.
- Angela Fuentes presents her ideas for the launching of the Safety Day to be held on June 5th with State Farm. WMTF will have a Radio Ad Contest which will be anti-meth specific to assist with community awareness of the Safety Day and meth prevention.
- D. Walker and J. Weaver presented a summary of the WMTF for the annual WASA meeting. This was well received. S. White reminds others of several different presentations available to meet community members' needs.
- Presentation will also be given on April 1st for the WUSD Staff and the WMS.
- Douglas Shoaff presents treatment availability for meth treatment called the Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Block Grant (SAPT). It is funding limited but is available for non-Medicaid clients. The program provides 9 hours of group therapy/week to assist with treatment of polysubstance abuse, including meth treatment.

- D. Walker reports the anti-meth billboard is posted in the Willcox area on I-10 with the generous donation from Clear Channel.
