

METH TASK FORCE MEETING NOTES

July 14, 2011

Present: L. Donahue, S. Lindsey, S. Richards, D. Walker, J. Weaver, S. White

- S. White made motion to approve the Agenda. Seconded by L. Donahue and passed unanimously.
- S. White motioned to approve Meeting Minutes from 07/14/2011. S. Lindsey seconds the motion which carries unanimously.
- No presentations to report upon. No new contacts have been received. No further contact has been made by either L.A. or N.Y.C. in which both were interested in pursuing a documentary on meth labs.
- S. Richards is present and advises what treatment options are available within Cochise County for psychiatric care and addiction disorders. She states \$3 million of funding for health care is slated to be cut within Cochise County. She also notes free counseling is available for the recent fires.
- Balance sheet = \$286.61. No PayPal deposits.
- S. White has submitted the application for the Northern Cochise Fund. No other grants are pending at this time.
- Reviewed request from the Quarterback Club to renew our bleacher sign. D. Walker moves to donate to the sign renewal. L. Donahue seconds the motion and passes unanimously. J. Weaver graciously offers to pay for the sign through the Community Fund offered by the WPD.
- D. Walker presents the ad created for the Encore Dance Academy Recital program for review.
- Time spent discussing the utilization of the WMTF website. D. Walker notes that site hits are down significantly since February.
- Ideas for the Fall WMTF newsletter are discussed. Agreed to pursue “meth look a likes and latest trends,” i.e. – bath salts, strawberry meth, etc.
- Discussed future plans for the WMTF as we enter into our 7th year. All agree to continue forward and “to say the course.”
- S. White provides WASA report. They are very busy with their summer program which continues to go well. She is also submitting a grant proposal for the Cenpatico Community Grant for funding to help finish the Skate Park.
- J. Weaver notes the State has made the possession of synthetic THC as illegal.
