

## METH TASK FORCE MEETING NOTES

- P. Stark present from the Elk's Lodge. The Elk's provides drug awareness on a national scale and they would like to assist the MTF. Reviewed a poster that was created in regards to candy meth which will be distributed.

- L. Donahue explains the Eagle Scout Project that her son is working on with the intention of it being a fundraiser for the MTF. WASA has provided the community center free of charge for a concert that will host several bands on September 15th.
- After further consideration of a grant, J. Weaver did not feel that the MTF meet the grant's criteria. P. Stark reports that there are grant opportunities through the Elk's that we may be able to access in the future.
